CORNERSTONE COMPETITION OFFERS WORLD'S LARGEST LIBRARYPRIZE

Grand Rapids, Mich. – October 30, 2009 – LibraryPrize invites students of all kinds from the Cornerstone University community to participate in a competition that will award nearly one hundred dollars to prize winners, including \$50 Mejer gift card to the student who receives the most public votes.

Details of LibraryPrize, which will run from Nov. 13 through Nov. 20, were announced Monday from the competition's host location of Miller Library. Like ArtPrize held in downtown Grand Rapids earlier this fall, LibraryPrize will have no formal jury, curator or judge. The Cornerstone Community will decide who wins the prizes by voting, using the web.

“It’s time to introduce the Cornerstone community to the new era academic library, and dispel long held myths that the library is a mere warehouse of old books in a world where all information is free through a Google search. LibraryPrize will be a celebration of creativity that hopes to bring CU together like never before,” said LibraryPrize creator Eric Bradley.

Miller Library will become art gallery. LibraryPrize creative works and performances will be exhibited throughout the one hundred fifty thousand volume library collection in the heart of Cornerstone University’s East Beltline campus. The library staff has offered up display cases and lobby spaces for displays, as well as opening up wall space for framed displays




“Our staff sees LibraryPrize as a new and innovative way to engage and support the Cornerstone community,” said library director Fred Sweet. Library outreach funds are underwriting LibraryPrize. “We share Eric’s vision for encouraging everyone to discover Miller Library and explore the creative spirit of the CU students.”

LibraryPrize is expected to draw over one hundred entries, and build on the excitement of ArtPrize by bringing a small scale version to the Cornerstone campus. Regarding student response, Bradley notes that it “so far has been of excitement and hesitancy. Many cannot believe that we are willing to open our doors up to such an experiment, fearing a stereotypical librarian will strike down any creative work that comes its way. This is exactly why this project is needed now.”

Miller Library of Cornerstone University is a hybrid information center of print and electronic resources geared toward the curriculum needs of Cornerstone University. It is home to the Curriculum Materials Center, an educational resource hub of educational collections and supplies, and the Cornerstone University Archives, which includes rare items in the Regular Baptist tradition and the papers of Robert T. Ketcham.

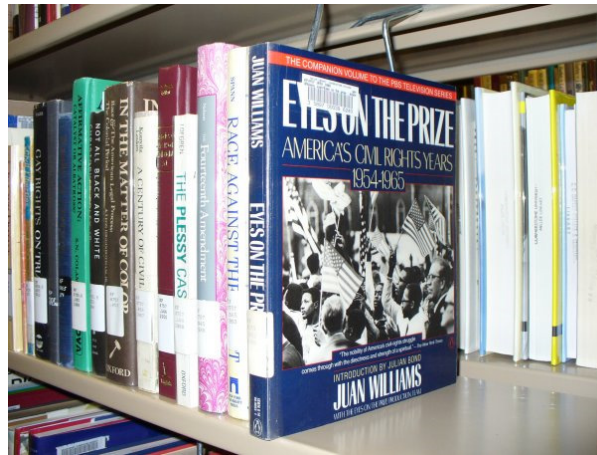
